All Monterey residents wishing to use the Monterey Transfer Station must have their permit properly displayed on the outside of the rear passenger side window of their car. These permits may be obtained from the Monterey Town Hall. Those who wish to hire a private hauler are still required to recycle and pay the specified fee. Please be aware that if these rules are not followed, the entire batch of recyclables could be rejected and returned. The expense of additional hauling and disposal will be coupled with the loss of recycling income for the Town. Separate recycling containers are available for paper, motor oil and CRT's. Solid waste is deposited in the trash compactor.

PLASTICS WILL NOW CO-MINGLE WITH GLASS AND METAL RECYCLABLES. PLASTIC LIDS CANNOT BE RECYCLED (please include them with your regular trash). **LIDS MUST BE REMOVED FROM ALL BOTTLES AND CONTAINERS** (please crush all plastic containers to conserve space. Please try not to break bottles and jars.) **WINDOW ENVELOPES CAN NOW BE CO-MINGLED WITH PAPER.**

ALL CRT'S (cathode ray tubes – i.e. computer and TV tubes) **ARE TO BE SEPARATED FROM ALL TRASH AND PLACED IN A SPECIAL RECEPTACLE PROVIDED.**

CLOTHES – THERE IS NOW A PROTECTIVE BOX FOR RECYCLING OF CLOTHES. THESE ITEMS WILL GO TO THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES AS NEEDED.

The Town of Monterey Transfer station will now be accepting items that previously required payment of a fee, for free. All items brought to the transfer station should still go thru the attendant, so that they may put in the right receptacle. Be advised it is mandatory that all residents recycle by Town Bylaw. Paper, bottles, cans, certain plastics, fluorescent lamps, batteries, thermometers, CRTs and electronics all must be separated and recycled. Construction and demolition debris will only be accepted on a limited basis, no contractors are allowed to leave construction materials, and homeowners can leave a small amount of materiel from a small project. Tires are now accepted.

Make sure your sticker is attached to your vehicle as specified and the plate number matches the sticker.
